

Consistent Concern

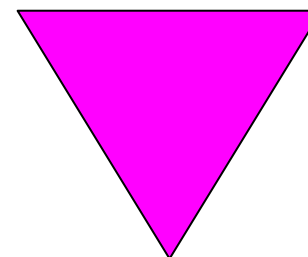
